Drawing Closer



Day 1

PRAISE GOD FOR HIS "RICHES OF GLORY"

PROMISE: "...The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come."

RESPONSE: Read Ephesians 1 and ask the Lord to show you how much He loves you today. Rest in the knowledge that you have a Daddy who wants to know you more and pour out His love over you.

JOURNAL: Ask the Lord to show you how much He loves you. How have you experienced His power and hope?

PRAISE GOD FOR GIVING YOU A PURPOSE

PROMISE: "In Him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of Him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of His will, in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of His glory." Ephesians, 1:11 &12

RESPONSE: Continue to ask the Lord to show you His purpose for you and JOURNAL what you are hearing He is saying to you.

JOURNAL: List all of the ways that you see what God has done for you, according to His purpose for your life.

WORSHIP OUR LORD, OUR GOD, OUR MAKER

PROMISE: "Come let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker; for He is our God and we are the people of His pasture, the flock under His care." Psalm 95:6&7

RESPONSE: Read Psalm 95. Then, get on your knees and worship God. Ask Him to teach you how to truly worship Him, especially in hard situations.

JOURNAL: Write down all the ways your can worship God. Worship is the strongest weapon against the schemes of the enemy.

PRAISE GOD, THE LORD OF ISRAEL, WHO CALLS US BY NAME

PROMISE: "...To subdue nations before him and loose the armor of kings, To open before him the double doors, So that the gates will not be shut: I will go before you and make the crooked places straight; I will break in pieces the gates of bronze and cut the bars of iron. I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret places that you may know that I the Lord who call you by your name, Am the God of Israel." Isaiah 45: 1-3

RESPONSE: Read Isaiah 45. Believe the Lord to open up doors and level mountains on your behalf! Worship the God of the Universe who loves you so much that He calls you by name.

JOURNAL: In what areas of your life do you need God to cut through bars of iron? List them and then praise God that He is already working on your behalf.

PRAISE GOD, WHO IS OUR STRENGTH

PROMISE: "Now David was greatly distressed for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and his daughters. But David strengthened himself in the Lord his God." 1 Samuel 30:6

RESPONSE: Read: 1 Samuel 30 and thank God for all the times that He strengthened you, when you couldn't do it on your own. If you are distressed, tell God about it and trust that He knows and is carrying you through it.

JOURNAL: Sometimes it feels like God has forgotten us and that the destiny He has for us will never come to pass but ask the Lord to keep your eyes focused on Him and for Him

WORSHIP OUR GOD WHO GIVES US COURAGE AND STRENGTH

PROMISE: "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9

RESPONSE: Read Joshua 1 and meditate on God's promise to Moses and to you - He will give you every place where you are to set your foot.

JOURNAL: Write down areas of your life where you know you are strong and areas where you are terrified or discouraged. Then ask God to replace that fear and discouragement with His courage and strength.

PRAISE GOD FOR BEING YOUR ROCK AND FORTRESS

PROMISE: "In You, O LORD, I put my trust;...For You are my rock and my fortress; therefore, for Your name's sake Lead me and guide me..." Psalm 31:3

RESPONSE: Read Psalm 31 and ask the Lord to show you how much you can trust Him and rest in the King of Kings & Lord of Lords to take care of you, to show you more of Himself and to fulfill His destiny in your life.

JOURNAL: Write down some areas where it feels hard to trust the Lord and ask Him to teach you how to lay these down at His feet and trust Him in a deeper way.

WORSHIP GOD AND HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS

PROMISE: "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." Matt 6:25-34

RESPONSE: Ask the Lord for His Kingdom to come and His will to be done in your life today. Ask the Lord to draw you closer to Himself spend time listening to what God is saying to you.

JOURNAL: What does it look like to seek God's Kingdom? How can you continue to do this each day? Write down some things you can do to seek God's Kingdom. Do something to encourage or serve someone today.

JOURNAL: Continue to communicate with the Lord as you seek His face and ask for His strength.

WORSHIP YOUR GOD WHO LOVES YOU ENOUGH TO PRUNE YOU

PROMISE: "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." John 15:5

RESPONSE: Continue to meditate on John 15. How do you remain in Him?

JOURNAL: Are you letting God prune you? Write down ways that He is and areas where you honestly realize you need pruning.

PROMISE: "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." Galatians 2:20
